SHOES:

- Appropriate shoes must be worn. These include **black** or **white** sports shoes or flat shoes, **black** lace-up or **black** fully enclosed shoes.
- For safety reasons, high heels, high platforms, thongs, ugg boots or backless shoes must not be worn by students at school.

CONSEQUENCES FOR NOT WEARING COMPLETE SCHOOL UNIFORM:

- Students will be provided with items of school uniform to change into at Student Services.
- Assistance is available to supply items of uniform to students where their families are undergoing a period of financial hardship.
