

ACCESS TO TEACHER SUPPORT

At PGHS we have ensured that all children have access to a Chromebook and charger. This allows your child to learn using technology. We have three platforms that support your child's learning:

On **GOOGLE CLASSROOM**, teachers upload learning activities and resources for your child, and provide feedback to support your child's learning against each activity. This is called formative assessment.

On **DAYMAP**, all teachers have uploaded detailed curriculum maps. These explain the tasks your child should complete, and what they need to do in each task to be learning effectively. Final (summative) grades will be entered on Daymap; parents can see what grade their child is on just by checking the Daymap Parent Portal!

Students have scheduled times to get support from their teacher. Their timetables (available on Daymap) will include a set time in which each class will have up to a 75 minute video conference on **ZOOM** with their teacher, during which teachers will be able to:


- deliver specific instruction on tasks and how a child can achieve success;
- create collaborative opportunities for students to learn by discussing topics with each other; and
- answer questions for students and parents about tasks.

To protect all children, students *will not* be filmed during this meeting. The teacher may film themselves giving instruction and showing tasks or share their screen as they provide students with instruction.

DEPARTMENT SUPPORT AND USING YOUR OWN RESOURCES

The SA Government has created a website, <https://www.education.sa.gov.au/our-learning-sa>. It has good resources on how to create a safe online learning space for your child. There are also some very helpful resources on home schooling to help you design timetables or strategies to help your child and give feedback, and engage them when they are struggling.

When helping your child learn, please remember your teachers have *already designed* resources for your child and the curriculum that are tailored to their academic needs. Using your own resources and units of work cannot be supported by your child's teachers in terms of feedback, assessment and reporting.
